

DIY Blind & Shade

INSTALLATION GUIDE



What You'll Need:

- Your Dynamic Sun Control Systems shade or blind kit.
- Tape measure, pencil, and level.
- Drill 1/4" drill bits.
- Screwdriver or drill driver (Phillips head).
- Step ladder (for high windows).

Safety First:

- Ensure your workspace is clear and safe.
- Use caution when handling tools or climbing ladders.



Before You Start

Step 1: Verify Your Order

- Unpack your shade or blind kit and check all components:
 - Shade/blind fabric or slats.
 - Mounting brackets (2-4, depending on width).
 - Screws and wall anchors.
 - End caps and chain (for roller shades).
- Confirm measurements match your window dimensions.



Step 2: Measure Your Window

- Inside Mount: Based measurements taken previous to ordering, blinds will come perfectly sized to fit. As such no additional measurement is required.
- Outside Mount: Outside mount blinds are manufactured 4-6 inches wider and taller than your window for full coverage.
- As such measure to ensure an equal amount of space is left on both the width and height of the window frame.

-For example, a **48"** wide window, the blind will be **54"** wide **(6" extra)**. Install brackets **3"** from each edge to maintain even spacing.

Installation Instructions

Step 1: Install Mounting Brackets

- Mark Bracket Positions:
 - For both inside and outside mounted installation, refer to steps above.
 - Use a pencil and level to mark screw holes.

• Drill Holes:

- Drill 1/4" holes at marked spots.
- Insert concrete wall plugs into drilled holes.
- If mounting into drywall, insert drywall anchors.

• Secure Brackets:

- Screw brackets into place using provided screws.
- Ensure brackets are level and secure.

Step 2: Attach the Shade or Blind (See tutorial videos for your blind type)

- Roller/Day & Nite Shades:
- Horizontal Blinds (2" PVC/2" Wood Horizontal):
- Vertical Blinds
- Bamboo Wood Blinds

Step 3: Final Adjustments

- Clean the shade/blind with a Swiffer (microfiber) duster.
- Verify the shade covers the window evenly.

Troubleshooting and Maintenance

Common Issues and Fixes:

- Shade Won't Roll Smoothly: Check for obstructions in the roller or brackets.
- Brackets Misaligned: Remove and re-level brackets using a level.
- Gaps in Light Coverage: Ensure measurements were accurate; consider an outside mount for better coverage.

Maintenance Tips:

- Clean shades/blinds monthly with a Swiffer (microfiber) duster.
- Avoid harsh chemicals to prevent fabric damage.
- Inspect chains or cords annually for wear.



Get the Most Out of Your Sun Control System

- Energy Savings: Lower shades during peak sunlight to reduce cooling costs.
- Privacy: Adjust slats or shade height for optimal privacy.
- Upgrade to Smart Controls: Explore our motorized shades for appbased or voice-activated control.
